**VOTE EARLY OR ON ELECTION DAY**

- Be sure you are registered to vote
- Early voting sites are available throughout Tippecanoe County
- Tippecanoe County residents may vote at any vote center
- Take your photo ID to vote (Indiana or Federal)
- Ask for assistance from the poll workers if needed
- If your name is not in the electronic poll book, ask for a provisional ballot and ask what you need to do to have your ballot counted
- Once you sign the poll book, do not leave the vote center until you have voted
